

Familiarization Programme Imparted to Independent Directors

On an on-going basis, the Company, through its Managing Director & / or Wholetime Director as well as other Senior Managerial Personnel, as required, conducts presentations/programs to familiarize the Independent Directors with the strategy, operations and functions of the Company inclusive of important developments in various business divisions, and new initiatives undertaken by the Company.
